When we get this right, the work looks completely different

- Residents experience better health and belonging in their community
- Community created ideas unlock the biggest gains
- Demand is prevented not passed around - delivery across council, VCFSE, health and resident groups as colleagues
- Relational working becomes the norm, reducing high-cost interventions
- Neighbourhoods gain real capability and the system saves money





Designed behind closed doors

Under pressure to deliver, some places risk unintentionally recreating the same top-down, institution led models that haven't worked in communities before:

- Early design is mostly happening inside organisations, top-down and data led
- The same people and organisations are around the table
- Residents and VCFSE organisations are brought around the table too late
- We are at risk of accidentally creating another paternalistic service/model
- We believe this is entirely the wrong way to do it.



We don't need to imagine a vision, we've built it

A community led, technology enabled, relational model that blends clinical care and social care with a new kind of neighbourhood capability.

- VCFSE as colleagues and equal partners in design, delivery and MDT working
- Residents shaping priorities, health creation and new roles
- Technology **creating connection**, not replacing it
- Prevention delivered through relationships not referrals
- **Test, learning and innovating** embedded throughout
- A version of neighbourhood health that residents recognise as part of their neighbourhood





A proven model of relational neighbourhood-led practice

- Facilitated testing, learning and innovation with residents, VCFSE and frontline staff (>350 people involved so far)
- Asset based commissioning to help people get the support they need
- Developed and implemented new relational roles in the community
- Building shared capacity, capability and ways of working across sector
- Embedding relational practice inside public services and clinical pathways
- Helping people live the life they want
- Stopping people ending up unnecessarily in hospital or social care
